### DESERT COURSE

Tom Fazio once again proved he is one of the most talented golf course designers in the world with his brilliant creation at Primm Valley Golf Club's Desert Course. Golfers will be transfixed by the desert landscape, as Fazio created an award-winning run that has golf packagers scrambling to make it part of a Las Vegas golf package.
